The 100th Episode of The Course Podcast



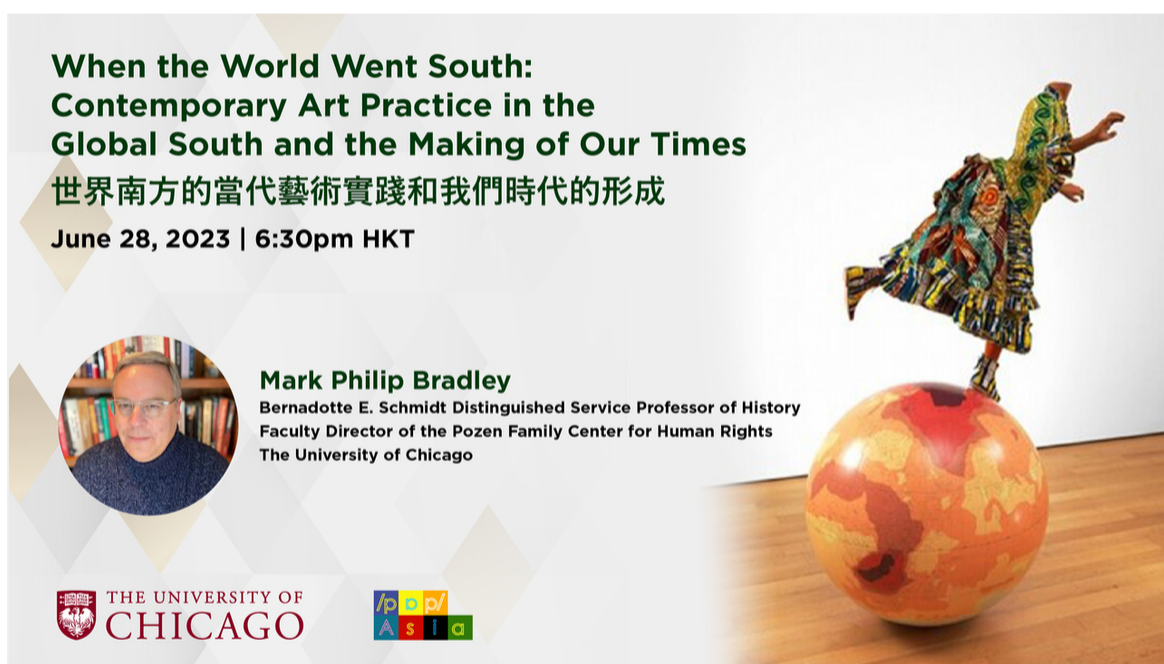
