An important reason for this is that patients' regular doctors generally have too few hospitalized patients to justify their daily presence in the hospital. Join us in the coming Harper Lecture by David Meltzer (LAB '82, AM '87, PhD '92, MD '93) to learn more about the Comprehensive Care Physician Model developed by him in response to this problem.

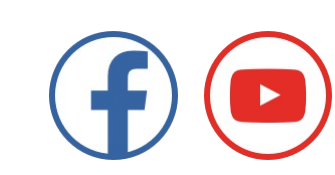
