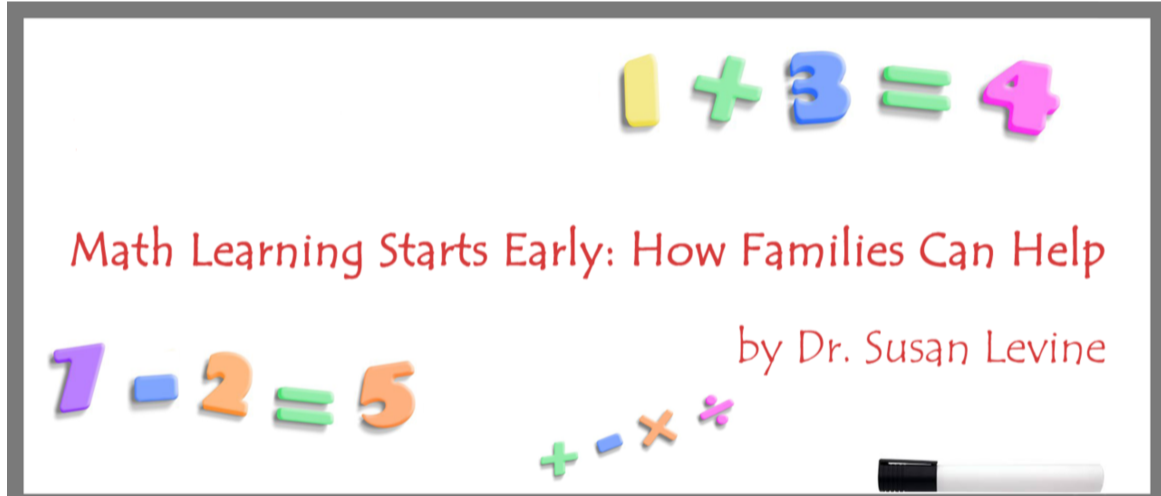
### Yuen Speaker Series — New Neighbors? Migration, Multilingualism and the Modern City (Mar 24)
