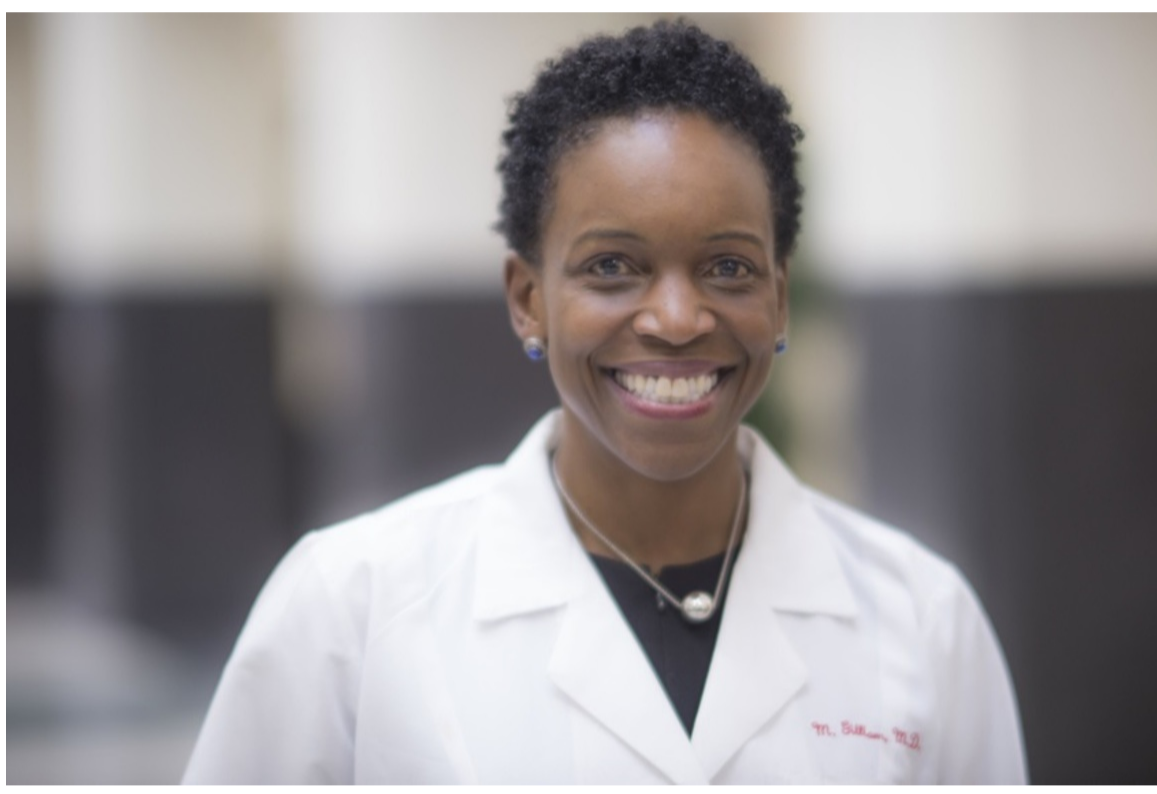
Palliative Care in the Community: Challenges, Experiences and Hopes (May 25)
