

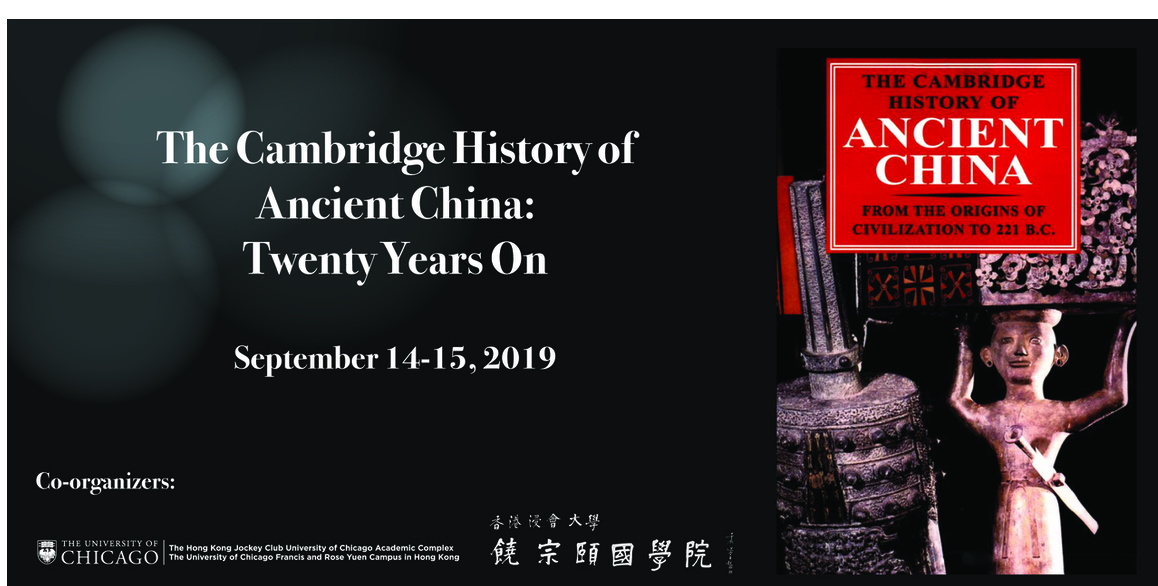

The Cambridge History of Ancient China: Twenty Years On (Sep 14-15)



2019 marks 20th anniversary of the publication of the book *The Cambridge History of Ancient China: From the Origins of Civilization to 221 B.C.*, a volume which combined both traditional historical records and the most recent archaeological discoveries to produce a comprehensive history of the period beginning with China's first written records in the Shang dynasty and extending through to the establishment of the Qin dynasty. Scholars from both the West and China will evaluate the book and the current state of the field in this conference organized by Professor Edward Shaughnessy, Department of East Asian Languages and Civilizations at UChicago.

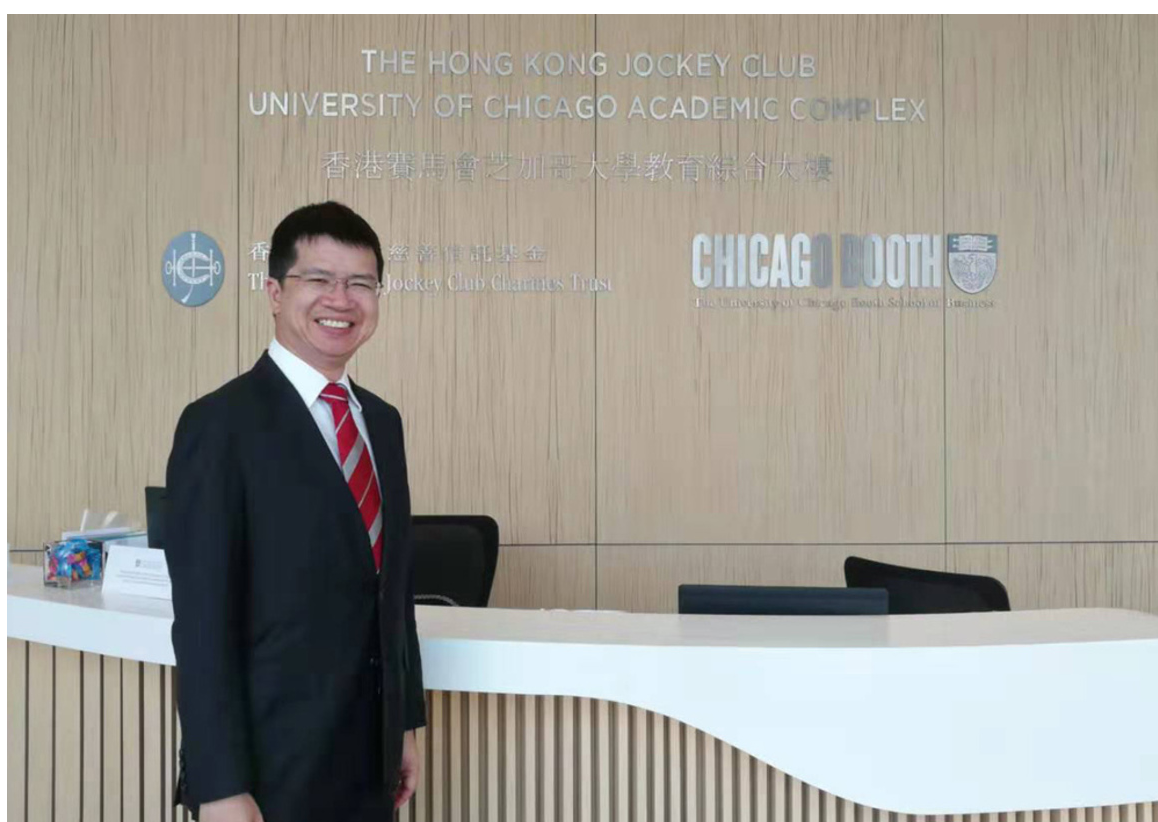
Yuen Speaker Series - Social Capital and Community: How New Technology Provides Insight into the Lives of Urban-dwelling Older Adults (Sep 16)



The characteristics of the places where we age have profound consequences for our ability to adapt to change and maintain independence. Social capital, for instance, is believed to be central to health across the life course, but what is it, and how exactly does it matter? Professor Kate Cagney's new study will provide one example of the use of new technology to address fundamental questions in social capital accumulation, urban sociology and life course studies of health.
