## On the Verge of Metropolis: Squatters in Hong Kong | Royal Asiatic Society Hong Kong Talks (Jan 19)



The squatters in Hong Kong dominated the city scene between the 1950s and 1970s. *On the Verge of Metropolis: Squatters in Hong Kong* 〇〇〇〇〇〇〇〇〇〇〇〇, a photo exhibition by Tim Ko, Historian-in-residence, will take us through a visual journey in post-war Hong Kong. **The exhibition is now extended to Mar 1.**

On Jan 19, Royal Asiatic Society Hong Kong (RAS) is bringing back Tim Ko and Dr. Patrick Hase, Honorary Fellow of Royal Asiatic Society, to share with us the life in squatters and the historical research findings of two squatter areas - Hau Wong San Tsuen (〇〇〇〇) and Kwu Tung (〇〇), a dispersed squatter settlement area typical in the New Territories. A total of 230 students had crisscrossed Asia bringing a 54% increase in Asia opportunities, which further demonstrates the University's commitment to fostering intellectual exchange and collaboration in the region.
