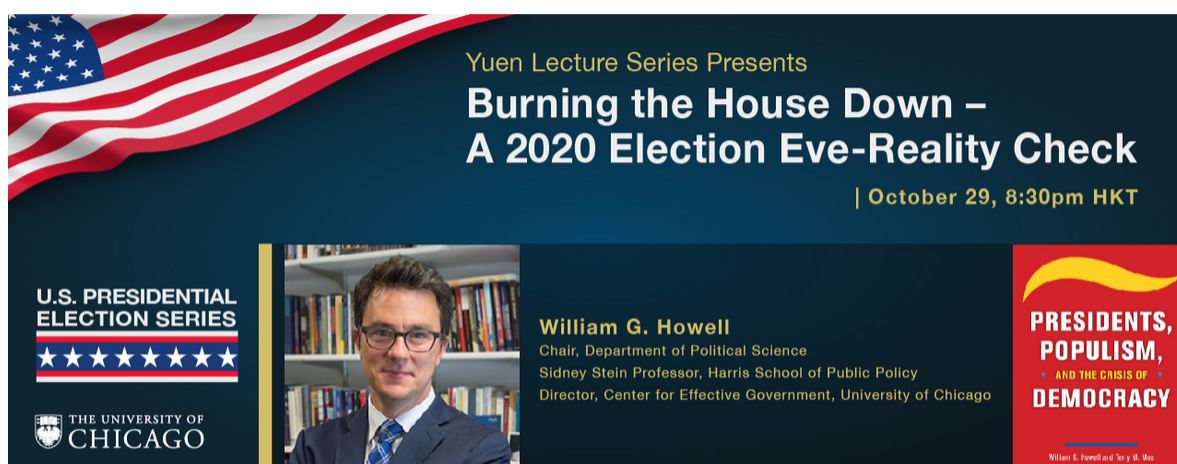

In the upcoming session **'[Burning the House Down – A 2020 Election Eve-Reality Check](#)'**, **[Professor William Howell](#)** of the University of Chicago will discuss his new book, *'Presidents, Populism and the Crisis of Democracy'* which will focus on what needs to happen in America if democracy is to be preserved. He will not only discuss the need for the U.S. to accept the crisis for what it is, he will also delve into how it came about and what its current trajectory is likely to be.
