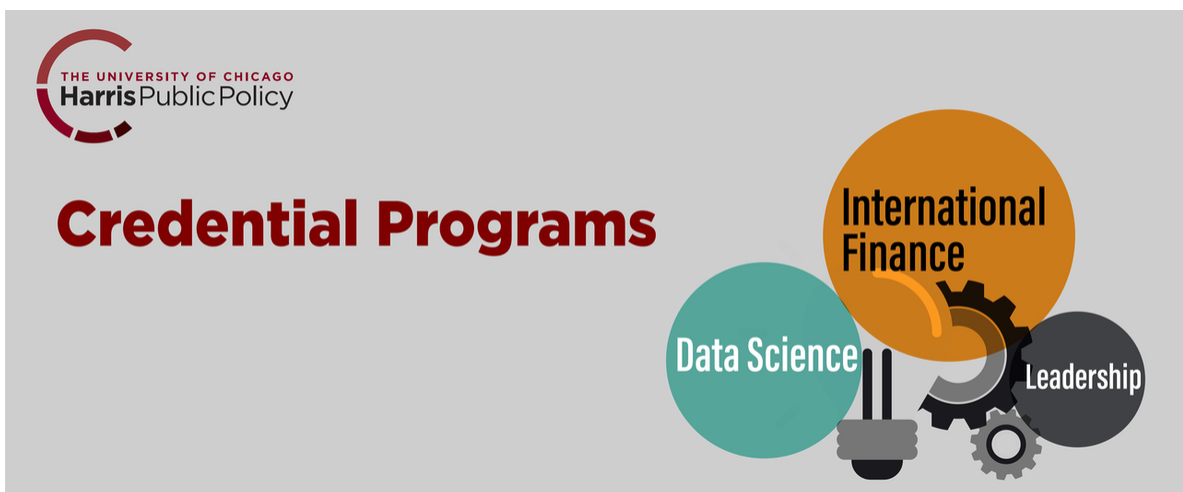
Tenth Anniversary of the UChicago Center in Beijing
