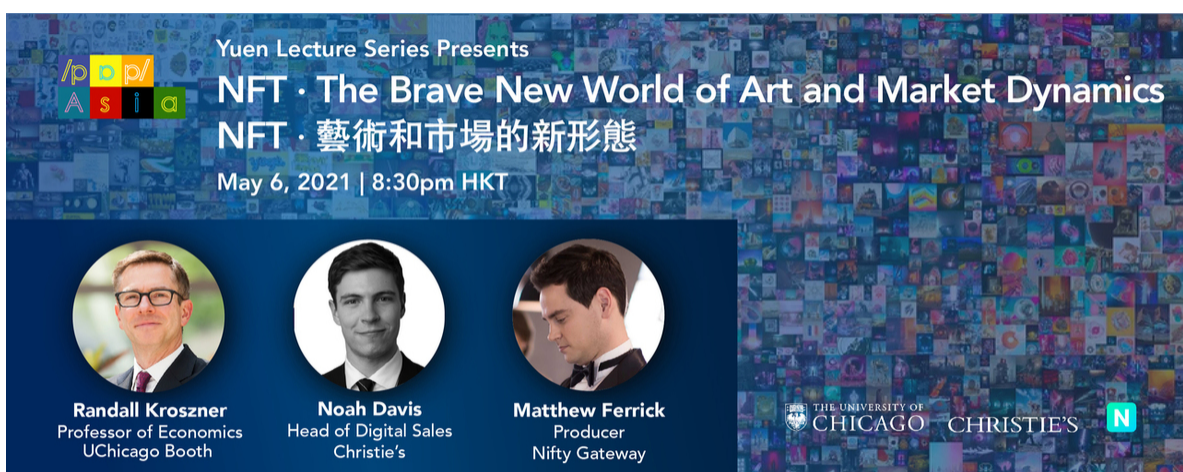

NFT · The Brave New World of Art and Market Dynamics (May 6)



With the rise of NFT (Non-fungible tokens) art values, online art and collectible marketplaces like Nifty Gateway have become a haven for digital artists to monetize and showcase their artwork. This phenomenon is rapidly expanding to the physical world as traditional auction houses like Christie's and Sotheby's have taken steps to merge with the virtual world by auctioning digital art and accepting crypto.

How are both traditional and new virtual platforms accelerating the value of digital art? Are digital art and collectibles genuinely here to stay?
