## Register HK Event: Is There a Chinese Path to Sustainable Development? (April 17, 6:30pm)




China's spectacular economic development of the last 40 years promoted a belief that successful economic development would be accompanied everywhere by convergence towards a similar set of institutions — in particular, an apolitical, technocratic, and government bureaucracy with a significant role in economic management. At the same time, some scholars insist instead on the distinctive nature of China's path to modernity.

Amidst increasing doubt about whether any society has a path to sustainable prosperity, this lecture looks at some of the distinctive institutions underlying Chinese growth and asks to what extent they may be useful (or harmful) in efforts to make modern prosperity compatible with environmental viability.
