Public Lecture: Truth and Communication (Mar 19)



False descriptions of child prostitution ring run by Hillary Clinton that is presented as actual news stories later turn out to be "fake news". White House Counselor Kellyanne Conway characterizes the misrepresentations of the size of the audience at the inauguration of President Donald Trump as "alternative facts". These events in recent American public discourse have led to concerns that we are entering a "post-truth" society. But what exactly is truth, and why should we care about it?

Come and join **Chris Kennedy**, William H. Colvin Professor of Linguistics at the University of Chicago, for a public lecture to examine the role of a truth convention in language: the foundational role it plays in meaning and communication, the ways that it is sometimes bypassed to make communication more efficient, and the ways in which it can be exploited for the purpose of deception or obfuscation.


Cross Cultural Perspectives On Decision Making in Medicine and Surgery (Mar 14 & 15)
