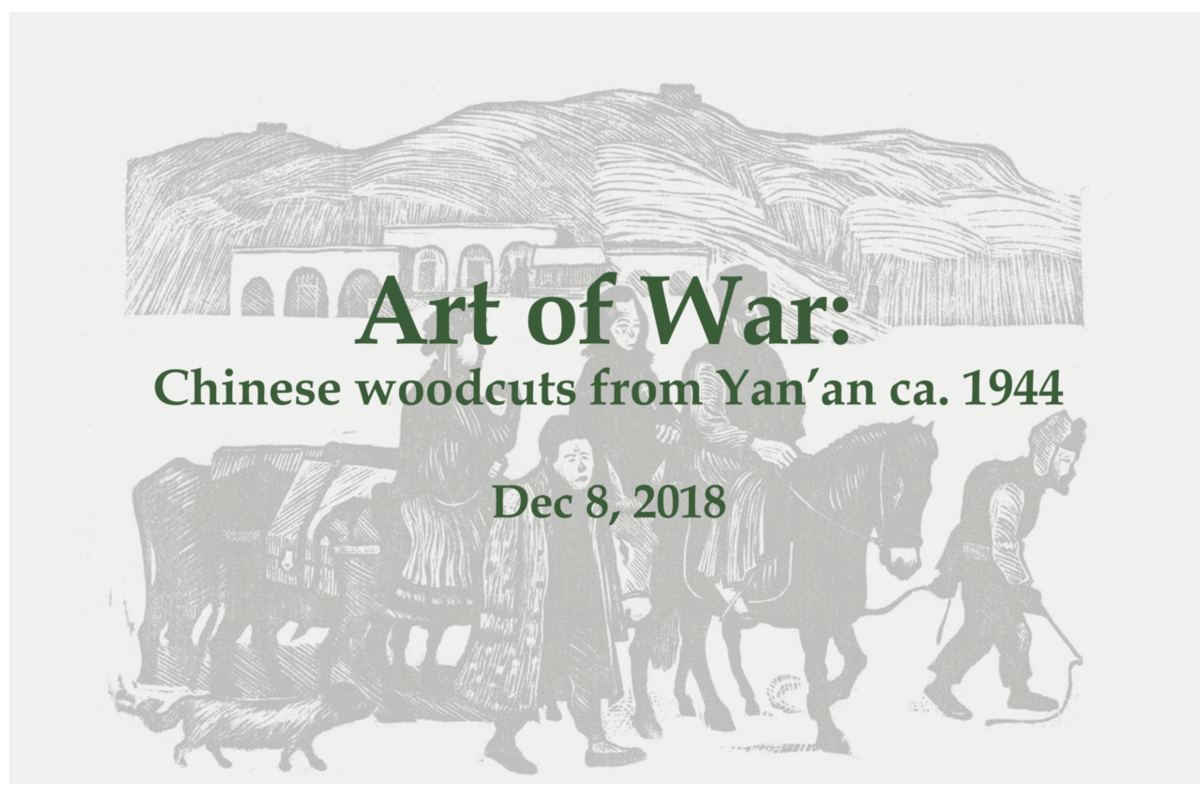

Art of War: Chinese woodcuts from Yan'an ca. 1944 (Dec 8)



Woodblock printing dated back to the eighth century and thrived during the Ming and Qing periods as illustrations in novels and new year prints. The popular origin of this medium prompted intellectuals such as Lu Xun (1881-1936) to use it as a means to educate the public and raise awareness of contemporary plight.
