

Hybrid Talk | Re-thinking the Hong Kong Tramway as a Rooted but Future Orientated Form of Sustainable Transportation (Nov 24, 3:30 pm)



As Hong Kong's most sustainable form of public transportation, the tramway has been in operation across the northern districts of Hong Kong Island for 120 years. The Hong Kong Jockey Club University of Chicago Heritage Courtyard and Interpretation Centre has organized a themed exhibition to celebrate the anniversary of Hong Kong Tramways and commemorate this important and historic milestone for Hong Kong transportation.

With the continued development of public transportation and some inherent restrictions in how the tramway can be used and accessed, the tramway in Hong Kong is facing a questionable future with passenger figures falling.

This lecture will discuss how the tramway could be integrated into future planning to revitalize the atmosphere and economy of the streetscape and realize the sustainability of the tramway.
