Half-day Event: Tram Exhibition Preview, Hybrid Talk on Sustainable Transportation and Heritage Tour (Nov 24, 2:30 pm)



As Hong Kong's most sustainable form of public transportation, the tramway has been in operation across the northern districts of Hong Kong Island for 120 years. The Hong Kong Jockey Club University of Chicago Heritage Courtyard and Interpretation Centre has organized a themed exhibition to celebrate the anniversary of Hong Kong Tramways and commemorate this important and historic milestone for Hong Kong transportation.

The half-day, in-person event includes a heritage tour, a hybrid talk, and an exhibition preview. The talk will discuss how the tramway could be integrated into future urban planning to revitalize the atmosphere and economy of the streetscape and realize the sustainability of the tramway.
