At least since the early 19th century, some women in the Pearl River Delta chose not to marry, deciding instead to become "zishunu" (自梳女), or "self-combing women". Some viewed these women as rejecting mainstream Chinese family conventions. Others saw this as an alternative within mainstream Chinese culture. Either way, the lives of these women represent a fascinating and distinctive phenomenon.
