## UChicago Tram Tales Exhibition on RTHK Vibrant Hong Kong on Mar 1, 9:30 pm



Since our “*Tram Tales: 120 Years of Hong Kong Tramways*” exhibition opened last November, there’s been an overwhelming response from the public and the media.
