Register HK Event: Why the U.S. is Frightening the World and What This Means for China (June 26)




Is the Trump administration inadvertently making China #1?

Unruly Spirits: The Rise of Chinese Medicine Therapies for Autism and ADHD (July 24)



Autism and ADHD awareness has grown rapidly in greater China. Parents and clinicians are turning to Chinese medicine for treatment, raising key questions about parenting perceptions, state policies, and evidence-based practice.

Professor Amir Hampel (UChicago PhD'17 Comparative Human Development) will examine these issues by presenting research with public health professionals, with clinicians developing Chinese medicine therapies, and on social media discourses about the use of Chinese medicine for autism and ADHD.
